

Drug Facts

Active ingredients Purpose

Glycerin (0.3%).....	Lubricant
Propylene glycol (1.0%).....	Lubricant

Uses

- temporary relief of burning and irritation due to dryness of the eye
- prevents further irritation

Warnings

For external use only

Do not use

- if solution changes color or becomes cloudy

When using this product

- do not touch tip of container to any surface to avoid contamination
- remove contact lenses before using
- replace cap after use

Stop use and ask a doctor if

- you experience eye pain, changes in vision, continued redness or irritation of the eye
- condition worsens or persists for more than 72 hours

Keep out of reach of children. If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

Directions

- instill 1 or 2 drops in the affected eye(s) as needed

Other information

- store at 15-25°C (59-77°F)
- keep tightly closed
- use before expiration date marked on the carton and bottle

Inactive ingredients

benzalkonium chloride (0.01%), boric acid, edetate disodium, potassium chloride, purified water, sodium borate, sodium chloride. Hydrochloric acid and/or sodium hydroxide may be used to adjust pH
